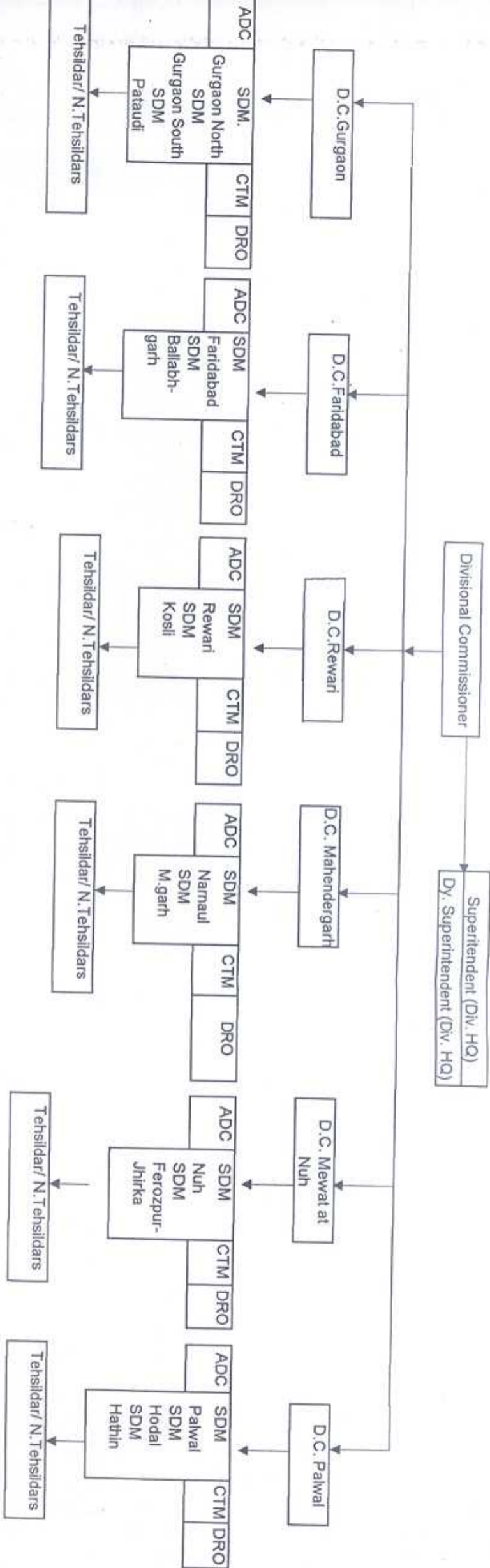


### HISTORY & BACKGROUND OF THE OFFICE

Gurgaon Division comprising of six districts is headed by the Divisional Commissioner, Gurgaon. Each district is headed by a Deputy Commissioner, who had under him an Additional Deputy Commissioner, Sub Divisional Magistrates City Magistrates, District Revenue Officers, Tehsildars/Sub Registrar. The Deputy Commissioner of six districts of Gurgaon Division report to Divisional Commissioner. He is the controlling and supervisory officer guiding their work. Divisional Commissioner also coordinates working of all the departments at the divisional level to effect synergy and sort out inter department problems. Divisional Commissioner keeps State Government authorities informed of all Department and problems to seek assistance and guidance from those quarters. Divisional Commissioner is also the head of the Revenue Department at the divisional level. The Six Districts are Gurgaon, Faridabad, Rewari, Mahendergarh, Mewat and Palwal. Divisional Commissioner to work Judicial process under Punjab Law Revenue Act 1887 Punjab Village Common Lands (Regulations) Act 1961, Punjab Tendency Act 1889 & others Act.
